

WE IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in CITY OF MADISON HEIGHTS

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

THE NORTH 110 FEET OF THE WEST 10 FEET OF THE NORTH 663 FEET OF THAT PART OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 LYING WEST OF STEPHENSON HWY SECTION 2 TOWN 1 NORTH RANGE 11 EAST

The route of the lines shall be, as follows: ANCHORS IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION, ALONG THE WEST LINE

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of FIVE & 00/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.

RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT FOR MICHIGAN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY
