Agreement. Made and entered into this 22^d day of Sept
A. D. 1916, by and between Willis Hough, Mayor
township of Oakland County, Michigan, first party, and THE DETROIT EDISON
COMPANY, a Corporation, second party.

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, first party, for his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby grants unto said second party, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate, and maintain, during the corporate existence of said second party, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, towers, wires, and fixtures upon, over, and across the property which he owns or in which he have an interest, in the township of Royal Oak County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, the route of said line being as follows: One hundred and twenty-two feet west of the west side of Benton Court and running North and South parallel to same; or one hundred and thirty-two feet East of the west line of Pine Crest Farm

Second party shall have the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and shall have the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires clear at least Four (4) feet, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.

Second party agrees to reimburse said first party, his heirs and assigns, for all damages to his growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

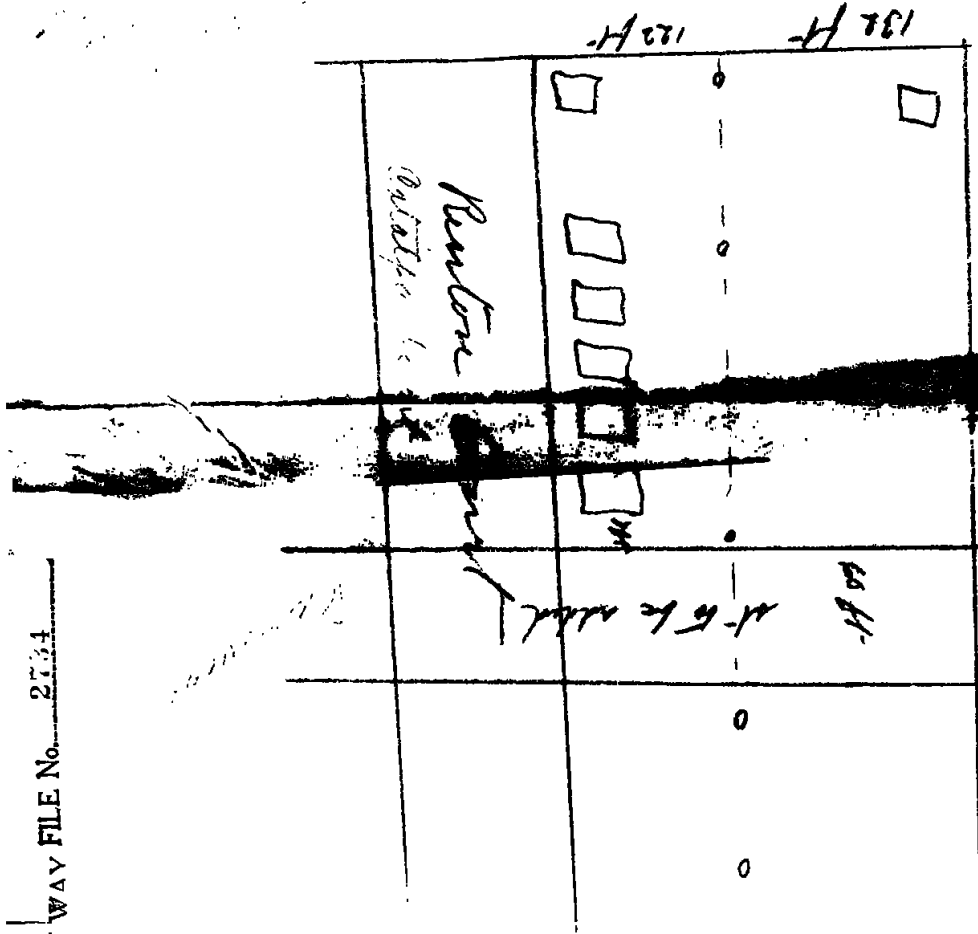
