

RIGHT OF WAY FILE NO. 3322

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Agreement

Made and entered into this 1st day of April

A. D. 1919, by and between Messrs. John, Edwin & Herbert Village of Ferndale of Oakland County, Michigan, first party, and THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a Corporation, second party.

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, first party, for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby grants unto said second party, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate, and maintain, during the corporate existence of said second party, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, towers, wires and fixtures upon, over, and across the property which they own, or in which they have an interest, in the Village of Ferndale of Oakland County of Michigan, and State of Michigan, the route of said line being as follows:

From the east side of La Prairie to the west side of Avondale, approximately 237 feet north of the eight mile road. Pole to be set on the lot lines.

Second party shall have the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and shall have the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires clear at least Four (4) feet, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.

Second party agrees to reimburse said first party, their heirs and assigns, for all damages to their growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, first party hereunto set their hands and seal, and second party has caused these presents to be executed the day and year first above written.
