The Detroit Edison Company, Detroit, Michigan, hereby makes application for authority to string the following wires over the tracks of the Grand Trunk R.R. in the City of Ferndale, Oakland Co., Michigan.

3ACSR-477 MM wires over the tracks of the G.T.R.R. located on the Right Mile Road at a point approximately 1150' east of Fair Ave.

Note: This is a temporary (90 days) crossing.
