

Gentlemen:

This is to confirm a telephone conversation with one of the men in your office, permitting you to construct an underground cable in the east side of South Main Street in the location indicated on your blue print, extending from a point north of Lincoln Avenue to the Ten Mile Road.

It is understood that you will be responsible for all damage caused to all underground structures which are encountered during the prosecution of this work, and that all trenches shall be backfilled in a manner suitable to the City Engineer of Royal Oak. It will be necessary to tamp the earth backfill for the full depth of the trench. It is further understood that where the pavement is cut the same shall be repaired in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer. It is also understood that all of the cost of this work will be borne by the Detroit Edison Company and that the City of Royal Oak will not be liable in any way for any damages caused by this construction. If it is necessary for the City to follow up this work and make any additional repairs, it is understood that the Detroit Edison Company will pay the cost of same, based on time and material plus 15% for overhead expenses.

I wish to call your attention to the fact that the City will not permit the connection of the 4" drains, indicated on your blue print, to the sanitary sewer. Such connections shall be made to the storm sewer system.

With this understanding the proposed construction is approved.
