

Attention, Mr. T. L. Hinks:

Dear Sir:

This is to advise you that an investigation has been made relative to your application to install underground conduit in Clawson Road, and Starr Road, in the vicinity of the re-location of the D.G.H. & M. Railroad. It is understood that the Detroit Edison Company desires to install these ducts while the bridge construction is in progress.

It is found that it would be more desirable to the City to have this conduit installed 23' North of the center line of the Clawson Road, or, 23' North of the center line of the middle pier of the bridge, instead of 25', as indicated on your blue print #U377-598. On Starr Road, in the vicinity of the right-of-way of the D.G.H. & M. Railroad, it is suggested that the underground conduit be located 9' South of the North property line of Starr Road, instead of 20', as indicated on your blue print #U377-560. This change is suggested because there is a water line located, approximately, 20' North of the South property line of Starr Road.

Permission is granted to proceed with this work, following the suggested changes, provided the following conditions are adhered to:

- 1- That you will exercise proper care to protect all underground structures encountered, and that you will be liable for all damage thereto.
- 2- That the trench opened for this work shall be backfilled by machine tamping, for the entire depth of the excavation.
- 3- That the City of Royal Oak will have the right to place an Inspector on this work, if deemed necessary, and that the cost of such inspection shall be borne by the Detroit Edison Company.
- 4- That the City of Royal Oak is not liable, in any way whatsoever, for damage suits or other claims arising thru these operations.
