Attention: Mr. T. L. Hinks.

We are enclosing your blue print #U-377-712 showing the location of a proposed conduit to be installed in the Eleven Mile Road between Washington Avenue and West Street, which has been approved by the City, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That you will exercise proper care to protect all underground structures encountered and that you are liable for all damage thereto.
- 2. That the City of Royal Oak will have the right to place an inspector on this work if considered necessary and that the cost of such inspection should be borne by the Detroit Edison Company.
- 3. That the trench opened for this work shall be back-filled by machine tamping for the entire depth of the excavation.
- 4. That tunneling operations shall be performed in such a manner that the undermining of any pavement slab or sid ewalk will be prevented and that the tunnel shall be back-filled with suitable material, packed thoroughly by machine tamping.
- 5. That the Detroit Edison Company will be liable for the repair of any pavement or sidewalk failure which may occur in the future in this location.
- 6. That the Detroit Edison Company is fully liable for any damage suits or other claims arising thru these operations.

You attention is further called to the fact that in order to install the conduit as shown on the plans it has been necessary to lower the catch basin leads one foot and to construct four catch basins one foot deeper than the standard depth. If it is necessary to reimburse the sewer contractor for any of this additional work caused by the change in the original design, it is understood that the Edison Company will be willing to assume this added expense.
