**IN CONSIDERATION** of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of

which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant permission to **THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY** its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so

as to keep the wires clear by at least eight (8) feet, upon, over and across over

property located in City of Royal Oak

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as

follows: Lot number 5 of Hudson and Hamman Subdivision No. 2 of part of the southeast quarter of section 21, T. 1 N. R. 11 E.

RECORDED RIGHT OF WAY NO. 9208

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Overhang of wires only from a point on the west line of said lot 5 approximately 29 feet south of the most northerly point of said lot 5, and running thence northeasterly across said lot 5 to Woodward Ave. Should said wires ever interfere with any building being erected on said lot the Company agrees to raise said wires so as to clear said building.

The Company shall reimburse \_\_\_\_\_ for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

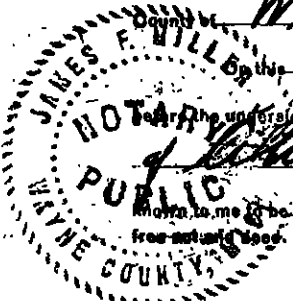
