WHEREAS, a Pole Line Permit, made on September 19, 1952, was given by HERMAN S. GREENE, BERTHA H. GREENE, his wife, and THE STATE SAVINGS BANK, SOUTH LYON, MICHIGAN, by F. N. Gready, Assistant Cashier, to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a New York corporation, granting a Right of Way to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY over property located in the City of South Lyon, County of Oakland and State of Michigan and described as follows:

Part of Southeast quarter, Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 7 East, beginning at a point on the North and South 1/4 section line distant south 1°13' West 1438.60 feet from center of section, thence south 1°13' West 825 feet, thence South 84°34' East 165 feet, thence North 1°13' East 825 feet thence North 84°34' West 165 feet to point of beginning, 3.13 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, in further consideration of said Right of Way, THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY covenants that:

- 1. It will not construct any lines for the transmission of electricity and Company communication facilities in a northerly and southerly direction along the east line of the above described property without first obtaining an additional Right of Way Agreement permitting it to do so.
- 2. It will remove all of its existing lines and equipment presently installed and extending in an easterly and westerly direction along the south line of the above described property on or before December 18, 1952.
