

I hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in CITY OF SOUTH LYON

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

PART OF SE 1/4 SECTION 19, T. 1 N., R. 7 E. BEGINNING AT N.E. CORNER LOT 1 WHIPPLE BLVD. SUB THENCE E. 61.20 FT. THENCE N. ALONG W. LINE OF STREET 100 FT. THENCE W. 204.20 FT. THENCE S. 100 FT. THENCE E. 148.0 FT. TO POINT OF BEGINNING. INTERSECT

The route of the lines shall be as follows:
IN AN EASTERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION ALONG AND ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH PROPERTY LINE OF ABOVE DESCRIBED PARCEL, ALSO ALONG AND ADJACENT TO WEST PROPERTY LINE OF SAID PARCEL.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of FIVE (500) Dollars for WIRING on said land, the same to be paid before any WIRING are erected.

RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT FOR MICHIGAN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY
