IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across out property located in CITY OF SOUTH LYON

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

A STRIP OF LAND 40 FEET WIDE ALONG PARALLEL AND ADJACENT TO THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF THE P.M. RR R/W, BEING A PART OF THE SE 1/4 OF SECTION 19 T1N R7E. Beg. AT THE SE CORNER OF E. RIDGE AND ORCHARD RIDGE RD, TH N 636.0 FT TO SW 1/4 LINE P.M. RR R/W WITH S 47° 21' E ALONG SAID LINE 1142.05 FT, TH S. 88.53 FT, TH N. 47° 21' W PARALLEL TO P.M. R.R. R/W 289.15 FT, TH S. 87° 15' W. 626.55 FT TO BEG.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

THE ROUTE OF THE LINES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS: IN A NORTH WASTERLY AND SOUTH EASTERLY DIRECTION, ACROSS SAID LAND, ALONG APPROX. 6 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTHERLY LINE THEREOF.

The Company shall reimburse NO for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay NO the sum of FIVE & NO/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected. SEE RIDER ATTACHED AND MADE A PART HEREOF
