Novi Township, County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the center line of vacated Gage Street (60 ft wide) with the N line of Lot 346 extended, of "Novi Manor", a Subdivision of part of the W 1/2 of Section 23, T 1 N, R 8 E as recorded in L 45 on Pg 25 of Oakland County Plats, thence E'ly along said N line extended 65 ft to a point, thence S at right angles 160 ft to a point, thence W at right angles a distance of 65 ft to a point, thence N at right angles a distance of 160 ft to a point of beginning. All adjacent to Lots 345.

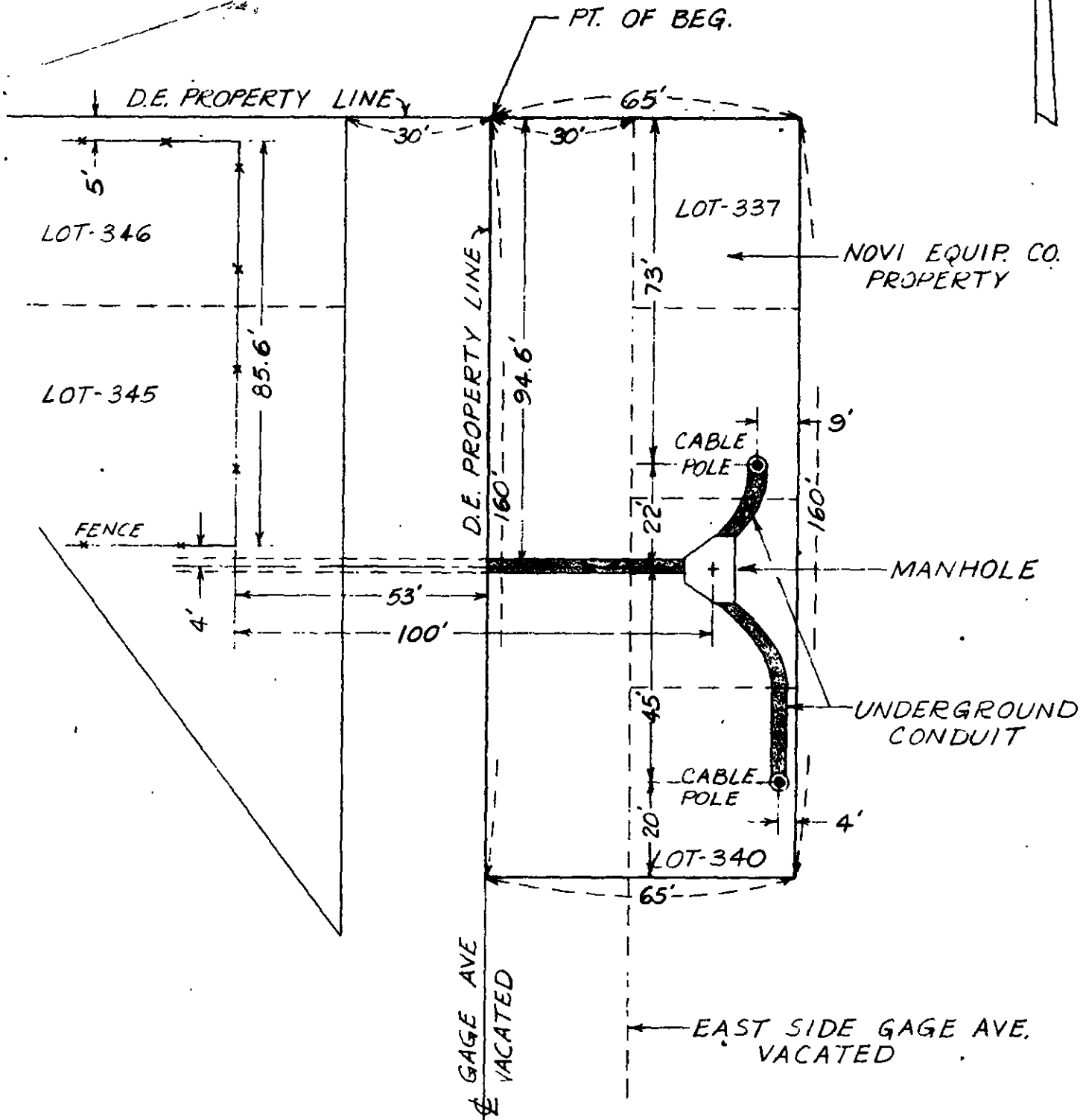
