IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain its overhead and underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, poles, H-frames, conduits, cables, manholes, fixtures, wires and equipment, upon, over, along and under a strip of land 200 feet in width and being a part of lands situated in Novi Township County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

That part of the North 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 8, Town 1 North, Range 8 East described as: A strip of land 200 feet wide described by its centerline, said centerline commencing at the intersection of the West 1/8 line and the Southerly line of said section, a distance of 1339.3 feet Westerly of the South 1/4 corner of said section; thence Northerly along the said West 1/8 line and making a Northeasterly angle of 89°30' with the said Southerly line of section, 1315.90 feet to an iron in the South 1/8 line of said section; thence Easterly along the said South 1/8 line and making a Southeasterly angle of 90°15' with the said West 1/8 line 90.95 feet to the point of beginning; thence Northerly along a line parallel with the said West 1/8 line, 305 feet to a point. Also that part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 8, Town 1 North, Range 8 East described as: Commencing at a point in the Southerly line of said section, said point being 1339.3 feet Westerly of the South 1/4 corner of said section; thence Northerly along the West 1/8 line of said section and making a Northeasterly angle of 89°30' with the said Southerly line of said section, 1258.33 feet to an iron in the Northeasterly line of relocated Highway U.S. 16 (300 feet wide) and point of beginning; thence continuing Northerly along the said West 1/8 line 57.5 feet to an iron in the South 1/8 line; thence Easterly along the said South 1/8 line and making a Southeasterly angle of 90°15' with the said West 1/8 line, 181.90 feet to an iron; thence Southerly along a line making a Southwesterly angle of 89°12' with said South 1/8 line 119.65 feet to an iron in the said Northeasterly line of U.S. 16; thence Northwesterly along the said (see reverse side)

The exact location and description of said easement shall be determined to be 100 feet on each side of a center line to be established by survey of said land to be made by the grantee on or before the 31st day of July, 1957. The location and route of the lines, conduits and related facilities as herein stated shall be within the width of the easement as finally determined. A description of said center line as established by the survey, shall be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds and thereafter, except for the right of ingress and egress, the rights hereby granted shall apply only to that portion of the land herein described over which the easement as finally determined extends. The right to enter upon said lands for the purpose of making such survey is hereby granted.

1. It is further understood and agreed that the Company, its successors and assigns, shall also have the right to clear and keep clear of trees the land within said easement, and no buildings or structures shall be erected on or placed within the easement without the written consent of the Company, its successors and assigns.

2. The Company, and its successors and assigns, shall have the right of ingress and egress to and from said easement over our lands adjoining said easement for the purpose of exercising the right hereby granted.

3. The Company, or its successors and assigns, shall reimburse the undersigned, or his successors and assigns, for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences caused by its men, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes herein set forth.
