STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The West 350 feet of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 20, Town 1 North, Range 8 East.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 220 feet east of the west line.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us me the sum of Four Hundred and no/00 (\$400.00) -- Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.
