across said land approximately along the centerline thereof.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company or its successors and assigns, shall pay US the sum of Four hundred and no/00 (\$400.00) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this 30th day of April A.D. 1962,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 7, 1956, OWNERS granted to EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining its lines for electric light and power over and upon premises in the Township of Novi, County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, described as:

The West 200 feet of that part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 17, Town 1 North, Range 8 East, lying South of Grand River Avenue (U.S. 16).

NOW, THEREFORE, EDISON does by these presents expressly release and abandon unto OWNERS all of the rights acquired by it by virtue of the aforementioned Right of Way Grant dated July 7, 1956, and in consideration of said release and other valuable considerations, OWNERS release EDISON from any and all claims, demands, damages and causes of action they may have against EDISON resulting from the acquisition, execution and recordation of said Right of Way Grant.

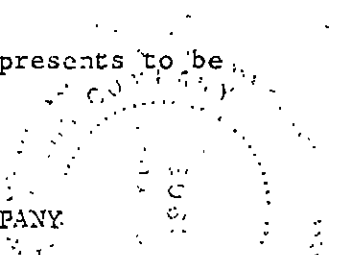
