

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this <u>36</u> day of <u>Afric</u> A.D. 1962, by and between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a New York corporation, of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit 26, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON", and WILLIAM DAVIS STAPLETON, Sr. and ANNE STAPLETON, his wife, of 48645 Grand River Avenue, <u>Novi</u> hereinafter referred to as "OWNERS".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 7, 1956, OWNERS granted to EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining its lines for electric light and power over and upon premises in the Township of Novi, County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, described as:

The West 200 feet of that part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 17, Town 1 North, Range 8 East, lying South of Grand River Avenue (U.S. 16).

which Right of Way is recorded in Liber 3567, Page 237, Oakland County Records, and WHEREAS, OWNERS have requested that EDISON release the above mentioned Right of Way Grant, and EDISON is willing to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, EDISON does by these presents expressly release and abandon unto OWNERS all of the rights acquired by it by virtue of the aforementioned Right of Way Grant dated July 7, 1956, and in consideration of said release and other valuable considerations, OWNERS release EDISON from any and all claims, demands, damages and causes of action they may have against EDISON resulting from the acquisition, execution and recordation of said Right of Way Grant.
