

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across <u>OUP</u> property located in <u>NOVI Township</u>

## RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this 30th day of October , 1964, between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a New York corporation, of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit 26, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON", and WILLIAM J. ALLAN, a married man, of 5768 14th Street, Detroit  $\delta$ , Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "OWNER".

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 14, 1956, William J. Allan and Celia L. Allan, his wife, granted to EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities upon, over and across premises in the Township of Novi, Oakland County, Michigan, described as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, EDISON does by these presents expressly release and abandon unto OWNER all the rights acquired by it by virtue of the aforementioned Right of Way Grant dated July 14, 1956.
