IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in

Novi Township

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The South 637.97 feet of the North 798.26 feet of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 8, Town 1 North, Range 8 East.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 1240 feet west of the east line thereof.  
The steel structure to be used for the purpose set forth herein is to be placed within 100 feet from either the North or the South property line of the property herein described.  
This agreement also includes the right to clear and keep clear of trees a strip of land 200 feet wide being 100 feet on each side of the centerline of the tower line.  
The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay the sum of Four Hundred and no/00 (\$400.00) dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INSTRUMENT, made this 6th day of December, 1963, between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a New York corporation, of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit 26, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON", and ALOIS PODLESNY and CAROLINE PODLESNY, his wife, of 25730 Dover Street, Redford Township, Detroit 39, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "OWNERS".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1956 OWNERS granted EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities upon, over and across premises in the Township of Novi (now City of Wixom), County of Oakland and State of Michigan, described as:
