I hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across my property located in NOVI TOWNSHIP

County of OKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

THE EAST 60 FT. OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7 TOWN 1 NORTH RANGE 8 EAST, BEG. AT A POINT ON THE NORTHERLY LINE OF W. 16 HWY, DISTANT NORTH 1° 07' 29" W 247.65 FT. FROM SOUTHEAST S&S CORNER, TH NORTH 72° 04' 35" W 329.04 FT, TH N 11° 51' 20" E 187.40 FT, TH SOUTH 72° 46' 16" E 283.35 FT, TH S 1° 07' 29" W 200.75 FT TO BEG.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ACROSS SAID LAND, ALONG APPROXIMATELY 52 FEET WEST OF THE EAST LINE THEREOF

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of FIVEY 00 (95.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.

RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT FOR MICHIGAN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY
