Ray, Executor as aforesaid, by virtue and in pursuance of the said several orders and decrees above referred to, and in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) BOLLARS paid to me the said executor by the said The Detroit Edison Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have said and disposed of, and do hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said The Detroit Edison Company, a New York corporation of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit 26, Michigan, its successors and assigns, forever, all the estate, right, title and interest of the said Ethel Kovacs, deceased in and to the following described lands, to-wit:

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An easement over the east 30 feet of the west half of the northeast quarter of Section 12, Town 1 North, Range 8 Rast, Novi Township, Oakland County, Michigan, excepting the easterly 90 feet thereof;

And also an easement over the east 30 feet of the south 20 acres of the east 65 acres of the west half of the southeast quarter of Section 1 in said Town 1 North, Range 8 East, excepting approximately 1.678 acres along the easternborder thereof described as beginning at an iron in the south line of Section 1, Town 1 North, Range 8 Bast, said south Section line being also the center line of Thirteen Mile Road, 1377.0 feet west of the southeast corner of said Section 1; thence northerly along the east line of the west half of the southeast quarter of said Section, making a northwesterly angle of 920 03° with said Section line, 812.14 feet to an iron; thence westerly along a line making a southwesterly angle of 88 09 30" with the last described line, 90.04 feet to an iron; thence southerly along a line making a southeasterly angle of 910 50° 30° with the last described line, 812.46 feet to an iron in said Section line; thence easterly along said Section line, 90.04 feet to the point of beginning.
