and to construct, operate, replace, repair and maintain thereon an electric transmission line or system in suitable structural form including accessories and appurtenances for the transmission of electric current for any purpose whatsoever, including the right to cut and trim trees and remove brush.

All damage to the property of first party (other than to trees) caused by maintaining, replacing or repairing said electric system shall be borne by the second party, its successors or assigns.

It is mutually agreed and understood that if the lands described herein or any part thereof shall be needed by first party, his successors or assigns, for highway construction or improvement purposes, second party shall forthwith remove from such part of said lands so designated, all towers, poles, accessories, material, equipment, appurtenances or property of any kind, Provided, however, that first party shall provide alternate right of way of equal width at no cost to second party over lands now owned by him adjacent to the lands described herein, reserving to the first party, however, the right to designate the location of any alternate route.

The cost of relocating said facility, in the event it becomes necessary, shall be borne by the second party, its successors or assigns.

It is further agreed and understood that if the first party, his successors or assigns, declares excess and offers for sale any of the lands over which it is proposed to locate the aforementioned alternate moute, then, in that event, the contingent obligation to move property and equipment assumed herein by second party shall terminate, the conditions pertinent shall expire and the second party shall have full use and enjoyment of all rights conveyed herein in perpetuity.

INTERDEPARTMENT CORRESPONDENCE

September 6, 1962

MEMORANDUM:

SUBJECT: Right of way across Michigan State Highway Department's excess property in Sections 18 and 19, Farmington Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

The original route of the Sunset-Hancock 120-KV tower line crossed highway I-96 property about one-quarter mile west of Haggerty Road. Discussions with the State Highway Department indicated that they would not be able to grant us a right of way at this location within the next two years. They suggested we consider an alternate route.

We moved the proposed right of way to a location one-quarter mile east of Haggerty Road. At this location, it would be necessary to cross approximately one-half mile of a land-locked 200-acre parcel of State Highway Department excess land. The Highway Department indicated verbally that they would be agreeable to exchanging the right of way we were seeking for some land which would provide them access to the 200 acres.

Through Rolfe H. Smith, Realtor, we negotiated an option to purchase Lot 20 of Indianbrook Subdivision, Farmington Township, for \$2,650.00 in order to provide the ingress and egress to the Highway Department lands.

The Highway Department advised me that they will soon have the necessary clearances to permit them to proceed with the exchange.

May I have your approval to proceed with this proposed transaction.
