

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this 19<sup>TH</sup> day of JANUARY, 1969,<sup>70</sup>  
between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing concur-  
rently under the laws of Michigan and New York of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit,  
Michigan 48226, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON", and STEVEN DARCEY and MADA E.  
DARCEY, his wife, of 46250 West Nine Mile Road, Northville, Michigan, hereinafter  
referred to as "OWNERS".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, on April 26, 1969 Steven Darcey and Mada E. Darcey, his wife,  
granted to EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing, operating and  
maintaining its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity over,  
upon and across premises in the Village of Novi, Oakland County, Michigan, des-  
cribed as follows:

The West 1/2 of the East 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4  
of Section 28, Town 1 North, Range 8 East.

which Right of Way is recorded in Liber 5358, Page 537, Oakland County Records, and

WHEREAS, OWNERS have requested that EDISON release the premises described  
above from the encumbrance of said Right of Way Grant dated April 26, 1969.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and  
other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, EDISON  
does by these presents expressly release and abandon unto OWNERS, their successors  
and assigns, all of the rights acquired by it by virtue of the aforementioned Right  
of Way Grant over the premises therein described.

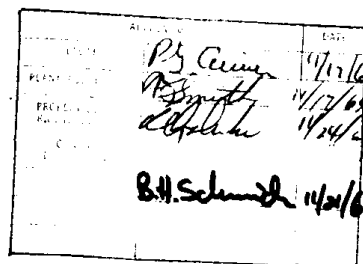
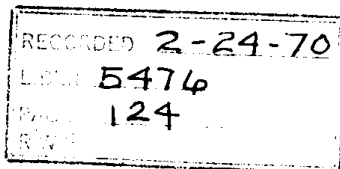

Dear Mr. Wilson:

This letter will confirm our understanding and agreement that for One Dollar and Other Valuable Consideration paid by the Detroit Edison Company (DE) effective as of April 1, 1992, CSX Transportation, Inc., hereby waives future rental requirements (provided there shall be no refunds of any prepaid rentals) and termination rights for the now existing aerial and underground wireline and pipeline crossing agreements identified on the attached Exhibit A. Except as described in the preceding sentence, the terms of all such agreements remain unaltered and in full force and effect.

Please indicate your understanding and acceptance of the foregoing by having the duplicate original of this letter executed on your behalf and return to the undersigned. No further revision of the individual license agreements will be necessary to effect the changes set forth in the first sentence of the first paragraph other than this letter exchange, which will constitute a supplement to each agreement.
