IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of

which is hereby acknowledged 1 hereby grant permission to **THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY** its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least eight feet, upon, over and across

property located in Township of Novi

County of Oakland STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The west 5 acres of the south 20 acres of the northwest quarter of Section 14, T.1 N., R.8 E. except a parcel of land in the southwest corner thereof being 48 feet in width, north and south, and 170 feet in length, east and west,

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land approximately 165 to 170 feet east of highway at west side of said land.

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences; caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
