

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in Township of Farmington

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:
The North 60 feet of part of the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of section 17, Twp 1 North Range 9 East Sec 17, as beg. at the NE corner of said W 1/2 of NE 1/4, Th. S. 380 feet, Th. W. 230 feet, Th. N. 380 feet, Th. E. 230 feet, to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:
In an Easterly and Westerly direction across said land approximately 52 feet South of the North line.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and 100/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
