STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of CHLAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The route of the lines shall be as follows: POLES IN AN EASTERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION ALONG AND ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH LINE THEREOF

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

ABOVE RIGHT OF WAY In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) Dollars for us on said land, the same to be paid before any us are erected.
