I T IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across 114 property located in FARMINGTON Township

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:
STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

Lots 62, ALSO 75+76 of Farmington Acres, a Subdiv of the South part of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 33 Town 1 North Range 19 East as Recorded in Feb. 21 on Page 10 of Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: An an Easterly and Westerly direction, Lots 62 along and adjacent to the South line, Lots 75+76 along and adjacent to the North line - Thereaf.

The Company shall reimburse ME for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay ME the sum of FIVE & 10/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
