IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WAVE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in FARMINGTON TWP STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:
THE SOUTH 6 FT OF THE WESTERLY 50 OF THAT PART LYING N. OF AND ADJACENT TO INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 696, BEING PART OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 17 T1N R9E, DESCRIBED AS BEGINNING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF THE N. LINE OF HOWARD RD, SO CALLED, - OVER -

The route of the lines shall be as follows: ANCHORS ALONG AND ADJACENT TO THE NORTH LINE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 696.

The Company shall reimburse NO for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

ABOVE In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay NO the sum of FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) Dollars for RIGHT OF WAY on said land, the same to be paid before any WIRES are erected.

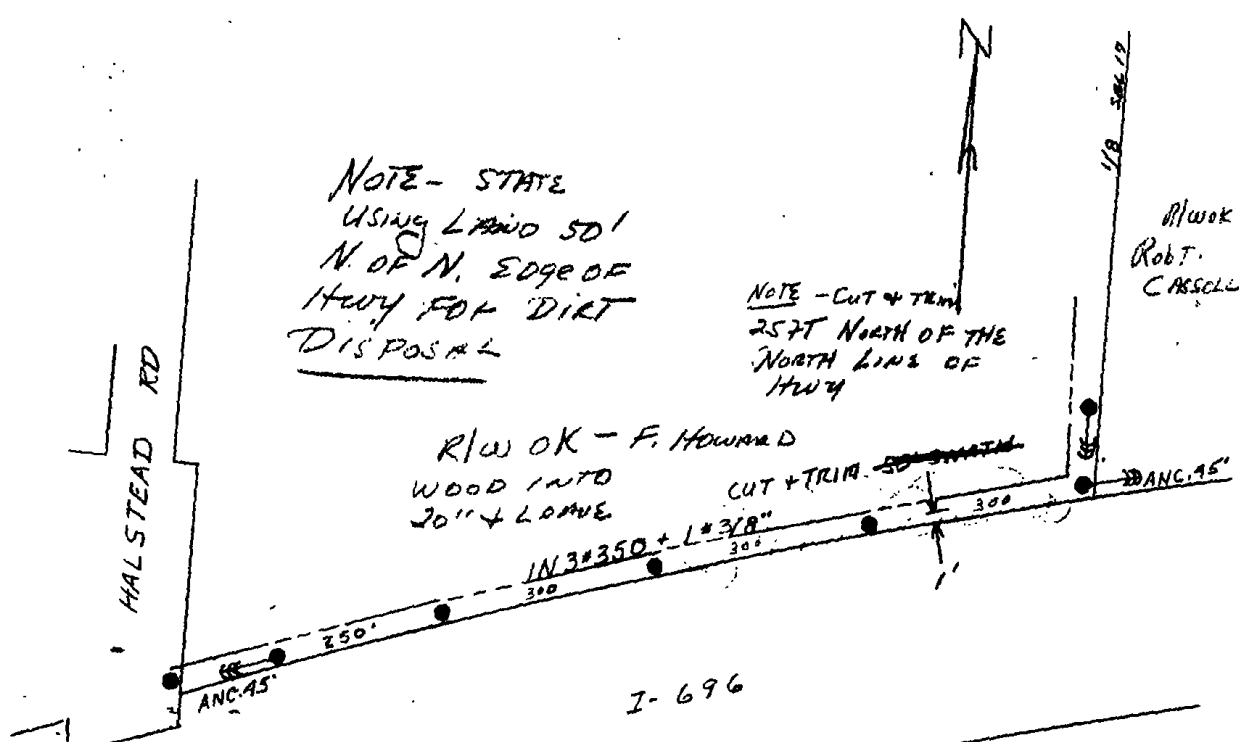

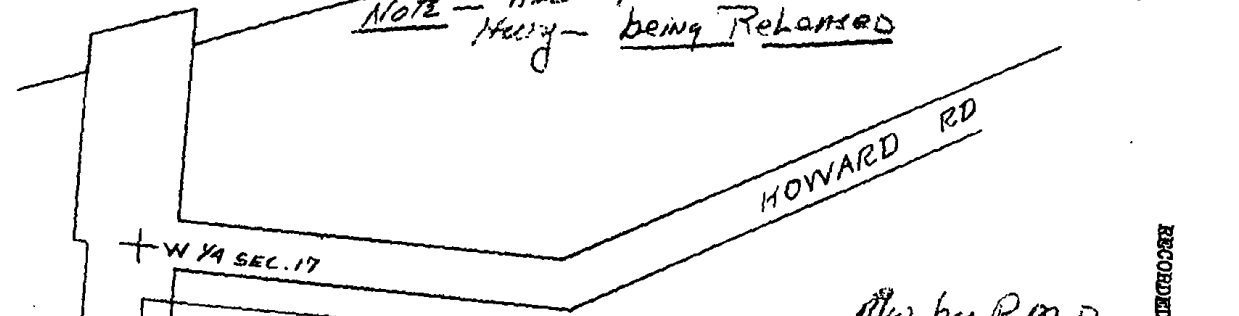
