IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in

City of Pontiac

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

A strip of land 12 feet wide the centerline of which is approximately 120 feet south of south line of Madison Avenue said centerline extending in an easterly and westerly direction and parallel to Madison Avenue from Arlene Street to a point approximately 25 feet west of vacated public alley thence in a northeasterly direction to the existing transformer pole.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Shown on attached drawing #0-2564, attached hereto.

This pole line permit to be effective immediately upon vacation of the public alley shown on said drawing.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

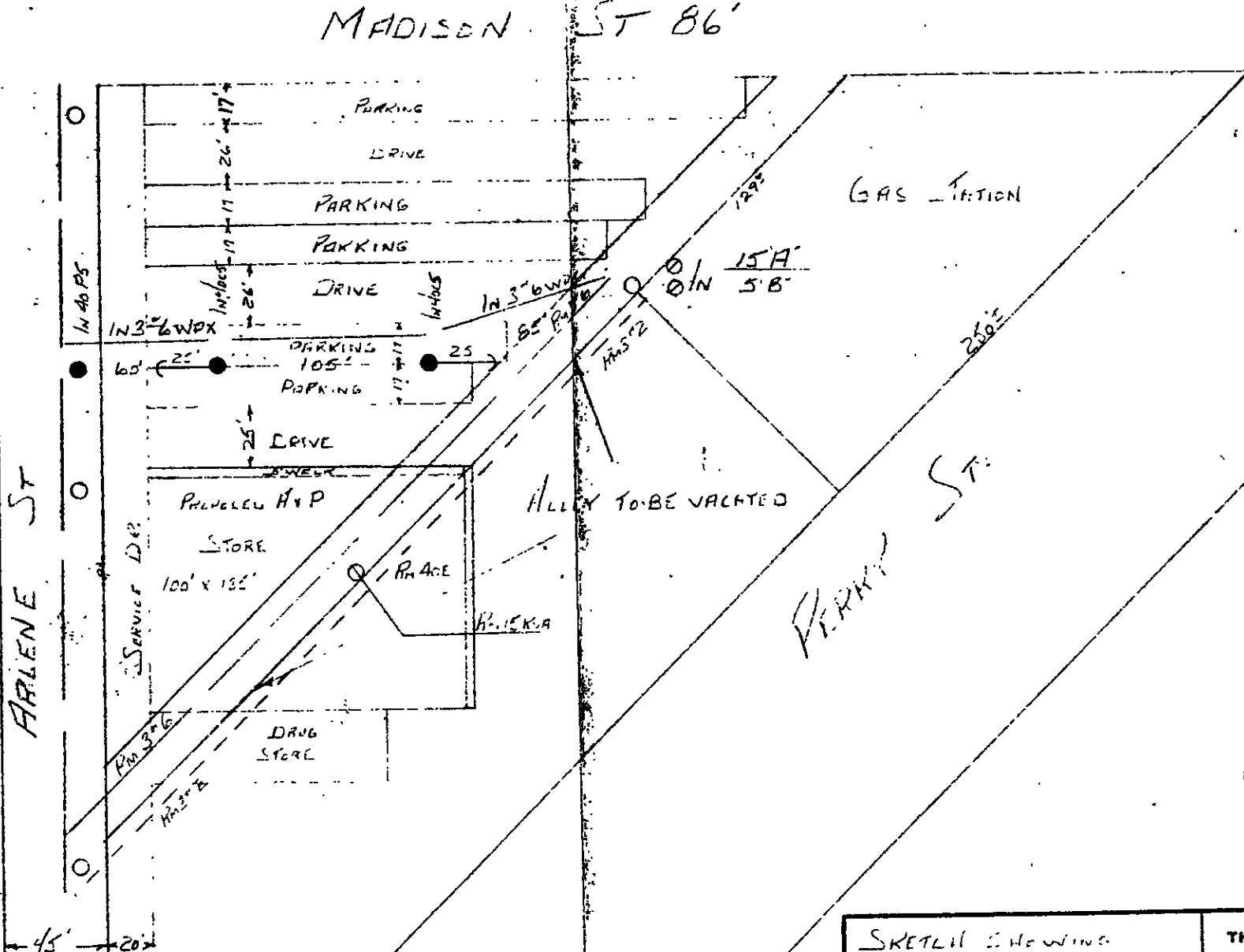
