IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One and no/100 (\$1.00) - - - Dollars and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary conduits, fixtures, cables, manholes and equipment, under and across OUR property located in the City of Birmingham, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lot 45 of East Maple Gardens Subdivision of the South 666 feet of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 30, Town 2 North, Range 8 East, as recorded in Liber 31, on Page 15 of Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across said land from a point on the south line approximately 25 feet east of the west line to a point on the west line approximately 3 feet north of the south line.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
