

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in Troy Township County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The South 60 feet of the East 1/2 of the following described land; part of the SW fractional 1/4 of Section 19, T2N, R11E, beginning at a point a distance West 700.52 feet from the South 1/4 corner, thence North 330 feet, thence West 611.70 feet, thence South 330 feet to the South Section line, thence East along said Section line to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across said land along approximately 32 feet north of the south line thereof.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay the sum of Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for above right of way on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected. See rider attached and made a part hereof.
