The route of the lines shall be as follows: in a northerly and southerly direction under and across said land approximately 35 ft easterly of the centerline of Coolidge Highway so-called.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

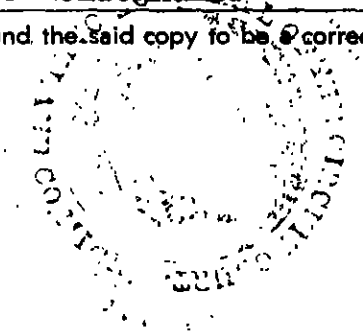

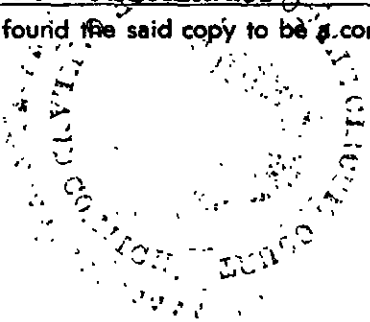
