IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in the City of Clawson

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The north 300 feet of the south 1500 feet of the west 1/2 of the northwest 1/4 of section 33, T 2 N R 11 E

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 47 feet east of the center line of Brooks road.

RIGHT OF WAY FILE NO. 1-8797

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
