IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One and 00/100 (\$1.00) - - - - - Dollars and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary conduits, fixtures, cables, manholes and equipment, under and across our property located in City of Troy, County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The North 60 feet of that part of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 35, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, lying West of the West line of Stephenson Super Highway, known as State Highway M-150.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an Easterly and Westerly direction along a line approximately 52 feet South of the centerline of Maple Road.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
