I hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across my property located in the City of Troy County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The North 60 feet of Lot # 29 of " Supervisors Plat # 10 ", a subdivision of part of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 27 and part of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, as recorded in Liber 46 on Page 42 of Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 180 feet west of the east line thereof. Also in an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the easterly 250 feet of the north line thereof.

Upon 60 days written notice the Detroit Edison Company shall make such changes and alterations in said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay me the sum of Five and no/100 - - (\$5.00) - Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.

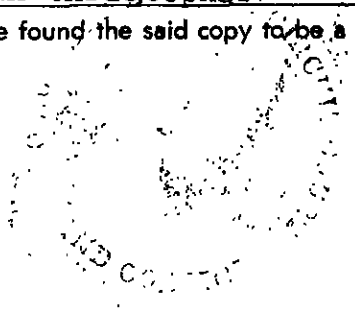
