IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in the City of Troy STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Part of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 27, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, beginning at the North 1/4 corner of said Section, thence South along 1/4 Section line 1760 feet, thence West 495 feet, thence North 1760 feet, thence East along the North Section line 495 feet to the point of beginning, except the West 95 feet of the North 400 feet thereof.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across said land, from a point on the most westerly line approximately 670 feet south of the north line to a point on the east line approximately 720 feet south of the north line.

Upon 60 days written notice the Detroit Edison Company shall make such changes and alterations in said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any (over)

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of Five and no/100 - - (\$5.00) - - Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
