We IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in the City of Troy

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Land in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 27, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, beginning at a point on the West line of the East 1/2 of said Northeast 1/4 of Section 27, said point being 922.13 feet South 10 35' 30" West of the Northwest corner of said East 1/2, thence South 10 35' 30" West along the said West line 338 feet to the North line of Supervisors Plat #10, as recorded in Liber 46 on Page 42 of Plats, Oakland County Records, thence South 87° 06' 24" East along the said North line 788 feet to the centerline of Rochester Road, thence North 13° 27' 30" East along the said centerline 360.94 feet, thence North 89° 00' West 865 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along approximately 210 feet west of the east line thereof and also in an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the easterly 300 feet of the south line thereof.

Upon 60 days written notice the Detroit Edison Company shall make such changes and alterations in said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any (over)

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and no/100 - - (\$5.00) - Dollars for above right-of-way on said land, the same to be paid before any wires are erected.
