2 1/2 WE IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across out property located in City of Troy

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The NORTH 60 FT OF LAND IN THE NE 1/4 OF Section 35, T2N R1E. Described as beginning AT A POINT S 89°41'W 910.40 FT ALONG THE N LINE OF SECTION 35, FROM NE CORNER OF SAID SECTION: Thence S 0°10'E 628.68 FT; Thence S 89°41'W 200 FT - OVER -

The route of the lines shall be as follows: IN AN EASTERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION ALONG APPROXIMATELY 52 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTER OF E. MAINE ROAD.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of FIVEY⁰⁰/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
