2-1/2 IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across OUT property located in the City of Troy STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Lots 57, 58 and 71

of "Big Beaver Poultry Farms" part of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, as recorded in Liber 23 of Plats on Page 14 of Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across said land along the north line thereof.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of Five and 00/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
