2 1/2 WE IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in City of Troy.

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:
The South 6 FT of the East 50 FT and also the East 6 FT of the South 50 FT of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 24, Town 2 North Range 11 East

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Across the above described property. -- Upon 60 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary AT THE TIME TO AVOID ANY INTERFERENCE WITH IMPROVEMENTS OR BUILDINGS IN COURSE OF ERECTION ON SAID PROPERTY.

The Company shall reimburse no for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay no the sum of FIVE \$/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
