UNDERGROUND LINES RIGHT OF WAY

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grants and conveys to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY of 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, 48226, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its underground lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and company communication facilities including the necessary conduits, fixtures, cables, manholes and equipment, under and across four (4) easements ten (10') feet wide located on premises in the City of Troy, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, to-wit:

Lots 16, 17 and 18 of Troy Apartments Sub. #4 of part of the north 1/4 of Section 29, Town 2 North, Range 11 East, City of Troy, Oakland County, Michigan according to the plat thereof recorded in Liber 121, Pages 10 thru 14, Oakland County Records.

The exact location of which is shown on The Detroit Edison Company Underground Lines Department drawing number U1-2-2630 a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

with full right of ingress and egress upon the said land to employes and appointees of the Grantee to construct, reconstruct, add to, modify, repair, operate and maintain said line facilities.

The Detroit Edison Company shall reimburse Grantor for all damage caused by its men, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
