Cablevision of West Oakland County, Inc., a Michigan corporation, 3166 Martin Road, Walled Lake, Michigan 48088 "Grantor's Land" is in the City of Troy, Oakland County, described as: Part of Southeast one-quarter (1/4), Town 2 North, Range 11 East, Section 9, beginning at point distant North 89°18'10" West 1115.17 feet from East one-quarter (1/4) corner, thence North 89°18'10" West 100 feet, thence South 01°04'22" West 330.99 feet, thence South 89°20'28" East 100 feet, thence North 01°04'22" Bast 330.93 feet to beginning except North 17 feet taken for McKinley Road, containing approximately 0.72 acres, more or less, Oakland County Records. Sidwell No. 20-09-426-025. The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as: The South Ten (10) feet of Grantor's land.	
1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead and underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories. 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area. 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent. 4. Excavation: As required by Public Act 53 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area. 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) and remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet enclosures. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in front of transformer doors. 6. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition. 7.
