IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in the Village of Milford, Oakland County, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lands lying in the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and the North half of the Southeast quarter of Section 10, T 2 N, R 7 E, described more particularly as follows: Commencing at a point in the South line of Liberty Street, said point being South 88 degrees 20 minutes 22 seconds West 425.00 feet from point of intersection of the Southerly line of Liberty Street of 66-foot width and the centerline of Main Street; thence South 1 degree 39 minutes 38 seconds East to the East and West quarter line; thence North 89 degrees East on the East and West quarter line to the East quarter corner of Section 10; thence South 2 chains and 20 links; thence South 88 degrees West 5 chains; thence South 32 degrees West 4 chains and 50 links; thence South 752 degrees West 8 chains 2 and 50 links; thence North $80\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 4 chains; thence South $64\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 4 chains and 50 links; thence North 76-3/4 degrees West 3 chains and 50 links; thence South $71\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 1 chain and 50 links; thence South $37\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West 5 chains and 38 links; thence North 42 degrees West 6 chains; thence North $73\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 3 chains and 50 links; thence North 67 degrees East 6 chains and 70 links; thence North 79½ degrees East 6 chains and 88 links; thence South 70½ degrees East 1 chain and 24 links; thence North 86-3/4 degrees East to the Easterly line of Cabinet Street (extended 66 feet in width; thence North 2 degrees 57 minutes 43 seconds West 8 approximately 899.00 feet to a point being South 2 degrees 57 minutes 43 seconds East 132.00 feet along the Easterlyline of Cabinet Street from its intersection with the Southerly line of Liberty Street; thence North 89 degrees 40 minutes 20 seconds East to an iron pin on Westerly bank of spillway; thence upstream along said westerly bank of said Spillway as it winds and turns to its inter-section with the Southerly line of Liberty Street 66 feet in width; thence North 88 degrees 20 minutes 22 seconds East along the South erly line of Liberty Street, to the point of commencement. A part of said description being now known as a part of Lots 90, 91, 93 and 94 Assessor's Plat of the Village of Milford as recorded in Liber 49 of Plats, on Pages 10 and 10-A, Oakland County Records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said land along East of and adjacent to Cabinet Street, so called, and Cabinet Street extended. Also in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction across the Huron River approximately 800 feet East of Peters Road.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
