IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys, and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in the Village of Milford, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

That part of Lot 90 of Assessor's Plat of the Village of Milford, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Liber 49 of Plats, Page 10, Oakland County Records, described as follows: Commencing 13 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 19 of W. A. Benson Subdivision in the Village of Milford, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 38 of Plats, Page 11; running thence South 263 feet, thence East 512 feet to a point on the West line of land owned by Ford Motor Company said point being on the East line of Cabinet Street (extended); thence North 210 feet 8 inches following East line of Cabinet Street to Southeast corner of Lot 28 of said W. A. Benson Subdivision thence Westerly following line of said W. A. Benson Subdivision to point of beginning, excepting therefrom the following parcel. Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 25 of the W. A. Benson Subdivision of the Village of Milford, Oakland County, Michigan, as recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Oakland County; thence South 4 degrees 36 minutes West 218 feet; thence due East 45 feet; thence North 4 degrees 36 minutes East 222.7 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 25; thence West 84 degrees South 45 feet to the place of beginning, being in T 2 N, R 7 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the South line and in a Northerly and Southerly direction along and adjacent to the East line.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks, and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
