IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across OUR property located in Village of Milford

STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Part of Lot 90 of Assessor's Plat of the Village of Milford, a part of Section 10 and 11, T2N, R7E, beginning at a point South 17° 30' West 1041.0 feet and North 87° 39' East 624.40 ft. from the north-west corner of Lot 90, thence South 22° 21' East 349.65 ft. thence 359.8 ft. North 74° 52' East, thence South 89° 25' East 361. ft. thence North 0° 35' West 473.3 ft. thence South 82° 0' West 719.0 ft. thence South 0° 04' East 119 feet, thence South 87° 39' West 122 feet to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northwesterly and southeasterly direction across said land from a point approximately 160 feet East of the Southwest corner to a point approximately 35 feet East of the Northwest corner of said land and in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction across said land along approximately 5 feet South of the North property line thereof.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
