IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in Village of Milford

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Commencing at a point 750 feet North of the Southeast corner of Lot 7 of Assessor's Replat of Bellevue Addition of the Village of Milford, T 2 N, R 7 E, running thence North on the East line of said Lot 7, 250 feet, running thence West 30 feet to a point, running thence South parallel to the East line of said Lot 7, 250 feet to a point, running thence East 30 feet to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction along and adjacent to the East line thereof and in an easterly and westerly direction along approximately 5 feet South of the North line, across the said land.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
