LICENSE FOR POLE LINE INSTALLATION

AGREEMENT made this 19th day of March , A.D. 1956, between GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, duly authorized to do business in the State of Michigan and having a principal place of business at 3044 West Grand Boulevard, Detroit 2, Michigan, LICENSOR, and THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a New York corporation, duly authorized to do business in the State of Michigan, its successors and assigns, whose street number and post office address is 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, LICENSEE,

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, LICENSOR grants to LICENSEE a Permit and License to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and LICENSEE'S communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guystubs, wires and equipment, and including the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across land in the Township of Milford, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, described as:

A strip of land 12 feet wide, the Centerline of said strip beginning at a point in the East line of Section 6, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, 80 feet North from the Southeast corner of said Section; Thence extending West and parallel to the South line of said Section a distance of 250 feet.

Also a strip of land 12 feet wide, the Centerline of said strip beginning at a point in the East line of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 7 East 1,800 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section 7; Thence extending Southwesterly a distance of 52 feet.

The location of said line is shown on the Detroit Edison Company Print attached.

The pole line is to be constructed and maintained in accordance with the National Electric Safety Code and the rules and regulations of the Public Service Commission of the State of Michigan, and the lines are to be at a minimum of thirty-seven and one-half feet above ground at the poles.

The License herein granted shall be revocable at any time upon sixty (60) days' notice in writing being given by General Motors Corporation directed to Director, Right of Way, The Detroit Edison Company, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan. Deposit in the United States mail, with postage prepaid, constitutes giving of notice for the purpose of this License.

If the License herein granted is terminated, The Detroit Edison Company, if so requested by General Motors Corporation, or at its option, shall remove said line or lines. In the event that The Detroit Edison Company fails to remove said line or lines, General Motors Corporation may, at its option, do so and charge the cost thereof to The Detroit Edison Company, which cost The Detroit Edison Company hereby agrees to pay.

The Detroit Edison Company shall indemnify and save harmless General Motors Corporation from any and all loss or damage to property or injury or death of any or all persons or from any suits, claims, liability or demands in connection therewith, however caused, resulting directly or indirectly by reason of the installation, maintenance, removal, use, existance or removal of said Company pole line arising out of or caused by acts, failures, negligence or omission of any other than General Motors Corporation.


