IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across OUR property located in THE VILLAGE OF MILFORD

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows: THE EAST 1/2 OF THAT PART OF

THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCEL LYING SOUTH OF GARDEN ROAD. THAT PART OF THE N.W. 1/4 OF THE N.E. 1/4 OF SECTION 14, T2N, R1E, BEGINNING AT A POINT DISTANT N. 89° 39' E. 978.34 FEET, TH. S. 48° 24' E. 147.8 FEET FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER, TH. N. 1° 22' 29" (OVER)

The route of the lines shall be as follows: IN A NORTHWESTERLY AND SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION ACROSS SAID LAND, ALONG APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET SOUTH WEST OF THE NORTHEAST LINE OF SAID LAND.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of FIVE AND 100/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
