operation upon, over and across OUR property located in WILFORD TOWNSHIP STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:
THE WEST 60 FEET OF THE NORTH 180 FEET OF THE
SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35 TOWN 2 NORTH RANGE
7 EAST

The route of the lines shall be as follows: IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION, ACROSS SAID LAND

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay ABOVE the sum of FIVE & 24/100 \$5.00 Dollars for on said land, the same to be paid before any Wires are erected.
