IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to **THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY**, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in the Village of Milford

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

A strip of land 12 feet wide, being part of the South 1/2 of Section 10, T 2 N, R 7 E, the center line of which is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line of said section, distant N 89° 54' 30" W 1345.94 feet from the Southeast corner of said Section, and proceeding thence along the future west line of Mill Street, 66 feet wide, North 0° 01' 30" (See Reverse side)

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an Easterly and Westerly direction, and in a Northerly and Southerly direction across the above described strip of land.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
