of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

WE hereby grant permission to **The Detroit Edison Company**, its successors and assigns to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also, the right to cut down any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least *four (4)* feet, upon, over and across *the* property located in *Section 34 Melford Township*

County of *Oakland*, State of Michigan, and described as follows: *1/4 acre tract in the south-east quarter of*

Section 34

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

Starting at a point approximately 100 feet west of U.P.R.R. on their south property line, thence northerly about 600 feet to Gravel Plant, thence easterly to highway.

The Company shall reimburse *us* for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
